- **85** new cases since 4/13/22
 - 31,506 total COVID-19 cases
- **7** new hospitalizations since 4/13/22
 - 1,343 total COVID-19 hospitalizations
- **3** confirmed deaths since 4/13/22
 - 567 total COVID-19 related deaths

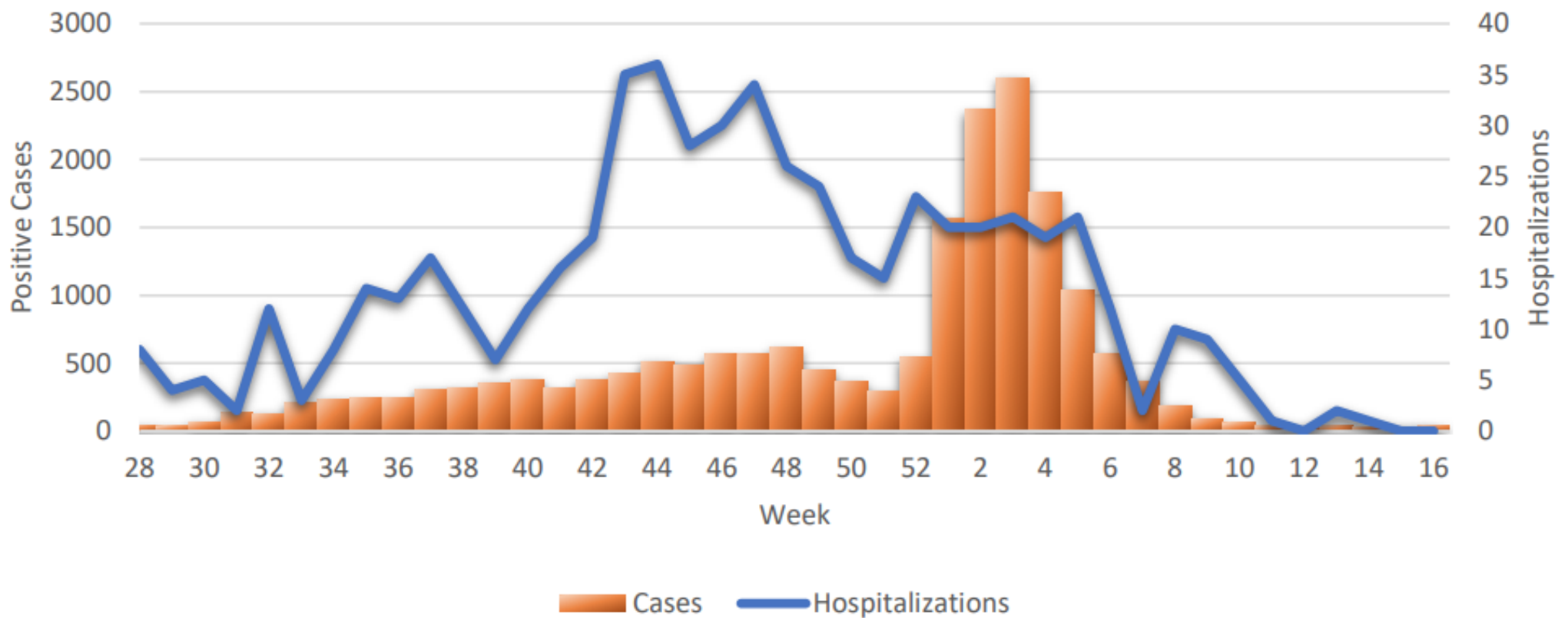
Note: The numbers reported are subject to lag, so there may be some discrepancy in the data previously reported. As data is received each week, prior case counts and rates are updated accordingly.

In week 16, there were 42 new cases reported in Cochise County with 0 hospitalizations. This is a 17% increase in cases and a 100% decrease in hospitalizations from the previous week.

Cochise County Schools Update:

- **1,360** school-related cases since the start of the Spring semester on 1/3/22.
 - **4** new cases in the past two weeks.
 - **0.3%** of total cases have been added in the past two weeks.
- **0/65** schools are currently meeting the outbreak definition.
 - Up **0** school in the past two weeks.
- **33/65** schools have met the outbreak definition since the start of the semester on 1/3/22
 - Up **0** schools in the past two weeks.

- ADHS COVID-19 Data Reporting Dashboard (azdhs.gov/covid19/data)
 - Data for Cochise County - County of Residence
- **204,375** total vaccine doses administered to Cochise County residents.
 - 3,025 doses given in the past 2 weeks
- At this time **78,620 (75.9%)** of Cochise County residents are fully vaccinated
